DON'T GET STUCK

In this part of the country there exists a type of cactus often referred to as the "jumping cactus." They are known as a jumping cactus because they have the joint attachment that are very loosely connected. The joints then will attach to a hapless passersby as they brush slightly over the cactus no matter how slight and they will stick. That is the reason why many people think that the cactus jump. The cactus are also referred to as the "teddy bear cactus" because of their fuzzy appearance. All cactus are nothing to mess with. If any cactus must be handled, extreme caution must be observed or unpleasant consequences will be realized.

Can these otherwise benign plants have any relevance to us as motorcycle riders? Oh, yes they can. The idea of losing control and riding off into a field of many varieties of cactus should conjure up a vision of, OUCH! But remaining on the road there are situations where it seems something jumps out at you and you get stuck. That truck or SUV might be hiding another vehicle that could pull out in front of you even though the shielding vehicle is granting you right of way. It seems we must always be suspicious and rightfully so. On one occasion a approaching pickup truck was turning left in front of me. Something told me that there was more. Sure enough the truck was pulling a cargo trailer that was obscured from view by the truck. I could have maintained my speed and collided with the trailer, but being suspicious saved what could have been a very unpleasant event. I didn't get stuck.

While knowing what is going on behind you is important, riders must focus their attention ahead and farther down the road. Any distraction can remove ones attention long enough to cause a panic situation or something even more serious.

Keep up those well establish good habits that have so often been mentioned so you don't get stuck.


