SAFETY CONCERNS

CONSTANT VIGILANCE

CRITICAL

What is critical to you in regard to your personal safety? It might be beneficial to be self critical to begin with. That would require a self assessment of what one realizes are their best and poorest riding skills. In the assessment you may recall some close calls that got your heart pounding and are etched in your memory. Naturally, rerunning the event mentally might be frightening but try to think of what you could have done to avoid it. Was I riding too fast? Was I following too close? Was I distracted in some way? Was I trying to keep up with others riding beyond my skill level?

Two very important things to consider as critical are intersections and cornering. Intersections are the most frequent locations for collisions with other vehicles. Being ready to apply the brakes in an instant can avoid an unpleasant or even tragic incident. Cornering requires road surface awareness as well as the many other hazards and surroundings.

While it's up to the individual what and how much riding apparel one chooses, more is safer and less is not. If a minimal helmet is all there is along with nothing to protect hands, arms and feet, the road surface would be a harsh teacher of what is critical.

Safe riding distance while among others is critical also. Be aware of how long it takes to move a foot to the brake pedal at highway speed. That one to two seconds it takes for that action eats up a lot of space. If another rider in a group must suddenly swerve to avoid something, an extra two seconds can make a big difference. When traveling at 65 to 75 miles per hour, occasionally select a road side object, like a sign, and mentally make a count like; "one space, two space, three space, four space," to gauge how many seconds you have to react.

Another critical piece of advise is: if you are pressed for time to get to an appointment or other important event, don't take the bike. Select another means of transportation. Being in a hurry could cause you to not put on your protective apparel.

There are many web sites to access for safety information. If you haven't done so yet, I recommend a visit to MC Rider on the Internet. There you will find hundreds of enjoyable, interesting videos on nearly every aspect of motorcycling.
