SAFETY CONCERNS

Roger Deevers, Safety Officer CONSTANT VIGILANCE



PERFECTLY SAFE

When are you perfectly safe? The simple answer is never because there is no such thing as "perfectly" safe. But there are measures that can be taken in order to be safer. Number one for a motorcyclists is a good helmet; preferably a full face model with a solid chin bar. Second is a jacket with included armor. Third, gloves that protect the whole hand not just the palm. Next, shoes or boots that are at least made of leather. Good habits are essential for riding safer. When approaching an intersection with cross traffic, covering the brakes, both front and rear, should be automatic. A large percentage of collisions are with vehicles turning in front of motorcycles. The all important "head check" is essential when changing lanes or merging into traffic.

Distractions are all around us. Many distractions are difficult to ignore because that's the way they are designed. Major intersections are often crammed with signs reaching out for your attention. One second or less of inattention can spell disaster. Not only our own distraction produces danger but others do as well. Someone driving through an intersection or approaching from an oncoming lane with cell phone in hand is not merely a danger but can be lethal.

We are free to be as safe as we want in choosing what apparel we utilize. But to make our journey safer, wise choices are a must. Stay vigilant stay protected and ride safe.




