

SHOULDN'T BEING SAFE ALSO BE FUN?


Motorcycle manufacturers have done a wonderful job of making their products reliable. While they are mainly vehicles of recreation we use them for commuting, traveling and touring too. Making a trip of several hundred or even thousands of miles on a motorcycle provides a feeling of achievement. It's amazing how short the trip seems when taking it on two, or perhaps three, wheels out in the open feeling the freedom. The time span is, of course, nearly the same as in a car but considerably less boring.

All of that openness means greater vulnerability. How vulnerable one wants to be is up to the individual. Some states require the wearing of a helmet while others do not. Legislating safety will always be met with resistance. Seat belt requirements started with a violator being cited only if stopped for some other violation. Then the "look for seat belt non wearer" enforcement took over. If there were a way for seat belts to be designed into motorcycles you can be assured that there would be strict enforcement requiring that it must be worn. Being strapped to a motorcycle however would indeed be more dangerous than not.

We're not required to wear a jacket, gloves, long pants, a helmet (unless legislated) or any apparel of substantial material. Ever see a picture of young lady on a bike wearing only a bikini, maybe sun glasses, and flip flops? She might be heading to or from the beach with her items for her outing, in a bag, that are afforded more protection than she has. Guys are often no better at protecting themselves. Tank shirt, head bandanna and sunglasses perhaps along with blue jeans as the only lower body protection.

Keep motorcycle riding fun. But it's no fun if you have an incident where protective apparel isn't worn. When the contest of flesh meeting road gets involved, road is always the winner.
