IN CONTROL

Question: what is always within your control when riding your motorcycle? Answer: your speed. Traveling too fast is the greater danger but traveling too slow can also be hazardous. Moving at the same speed/rate of traffic is usually a good allowance. But if traffic is moving faster than what is comfortable, looking for alternate positions is advisable.

Other things that are in our control are our choice of riding apparel. No matter how much it has been urged, some will still chose to ride unprotected. Yes, it's a personal choice. Tire pressure is extremely important to insure proper handling. Also the age of the tires should be monitored. There should be a date code on the side of the tire. Molded in is a oval panel with four numbers. The first two numbers are the the week of the year that the tired is made and the second two numbers are the year. Example: 1219 indicates that the tire was made in the twelfth week of the year 2019.

More things in our control are attitude and good habits. There are plenty of aggressive riders trying to impress everyone around them by putting on a demonstration. Overcoming that bad image requires our establishing a good rapport with others on the road. Good habits sometimes requires being self critical and mentally correcting oneself when realizing a mistake was made. Head check, avoiding distraction, proper speed and following distance help keep us in control and riding safe.


