#### March meeting notes:

Ellen Davidson brought 2 guests, Bonnie and Mike (visiting). Time flies - a few of our snow birds will leaving for home before our next meeting (so sad to see them leave). Our weather has finally begun to cooperate and we are riding more. Taco Sunday (March 19th) will be Dave Piper's last one for the season (he leaves in April - just before the next Taco Sunday). The April Taco Sunday will be lead by Dennis Johnson - meeting at Circle K intersection of Ajo and Kinney Road will be the new meet site. Details on time will be determined. Next meeting is April 9 (Easter Sunday). We will still have a meeting. Our April ride planning meeting will be at the Dickerson's garage (inside or back porch) depending upon the weather. Saturday, April 15 at Noon. Ride planning will be first followed by lunch. Brown bag lunch - beverages (water, lemonade, tea, cups, plates) will be provided by Dan and Aina Dickerson.

Roger Deevers spoke about some cool accessories for motorcycles (locks for handlebars, LED lights) that he saw on Facebook. Also he spoke about staggering your bikes in a group ride - including 3 wheel bikes. Even though 3-wheels have a larger footprint than 2-wheelers - staggering is still a good strategy for riding in a group. Remember we have new members who may not be familiar with group riding and are new to our group. We need to continue our practice of ride announcements (route, rest stops, keeping new members within our sights in the group, etc.). We want everyone to enjoy the ride and feel comfortable. Jim Rohlman mentioned a book "Proficient Motorcycling" - gives tips and tricks to stay safe while riding a motorcycle.

Lee Aitken and Jim Rohlman stated that Mercedes Benz will be advertising a self driven vehicle that will allow the driver to watch a video/movie while traveling (hands free). Jim stated there will be self driven vehicles without any controls (no steering wheel, etc.). As Roger has always told us - keep watch on everyone.

There was much discussion about our TucsonMotorCycle.com website. The name was the concern -- if you google "Retreads" - since it is not in the name how to people find us. Andrew was at our meeting and said he would look at our options to incorporate or redirect to our website when searching for our weblink. The website address has been listed in our newsletter under "Tucson Staff", websites (both our local and Retreads international) for everyone's convenience. There was discussion about the "members" only link on our website. To get to that area you must use a password - in order to get into the members only area an administrator must validate you are a current member before you will be accepted into the members only area. There is the option to create your own unique password too. A feature that is in development is an "announcement" board - this will act as a messenger board where impromptu rides can be posted. Another development project is the ability to have a ride added to your personal calendar - thus creating an automatic event on your calendar.

Remember we meet Easter Sunday in April.

#### **MAKE IT YOUR ROAD**

The stand-up comedian Rodney Dangerfield often expressed that he didn't get any respect. The description of the situations in which he didn't get any respect were usually those that everyone could identify with. However motorcyclists occasionally find themselves in a situation where they don't get any respect, but it's not humorous.

At times the disrespect may be invited. It's our road just as much as it is for any other legal vehicle so taking up your lane can declare dominance in your sphere of existence.

Your position in the lane communicates to others what you will or won't tolerate. Most riders prefer center or left of center position. Taking the right side of the lane, when not in a group ride, can give drivers of vehicles an invitation to crowd or to inappropriately pass. Trying to not be a nuisance to others is helpful to the image of motorcycling as a whole, and we have all seen nuisance riders: lane splitters who erroneously believe lane filtering grants permission to "lane split." We also have experienced the driver who no matter how fast you are going, simply must pass to be the champion arriving at the traffic light first. At the best opportunity get out of their way and let the racers race. But, it's your road and your lane as much as everyone else's when used properly.
