SUMMERTIME

Now that summer has officially arrived and attention needs to be paid to dehydration.

We will be enjoying those warmer, even HOT temperatures so use extra caution.

Everyone should be carrying water. Getting stranded and being without water here in the dry zone can be dangerous. Also be aware of the symptoms of dehydration.

If you have mild to moderate dehydration you might:

Be thirsty

Have a dry mouth, lips and tongue

Be dizzy or light-headed, particularly when standing up,

Have a headache

Have dark urine and not eliminate as much volume as normal.

Caffeine is a diuretic which makes your kidneys remove fluid from your body and cause you to need to urinate more often resulting in dehydration.

Avoid caffeine before embarking on a ride and remain comfortable and hydrated longer.

When was the last time you checked your tire pressure? While doing so examine the tire wear and the date the tire was manufactured. The date code is in the oval panel pressed on the side of the tire like other information. The first two numbers are the week of the year and the last two are the year. The code is updated weekly, not daily. A number 1221 would mean the tire was manufactured the 12th week of the year 2021.

Keep up those good habits and most importantly do that head check when merging, changing lanes and going through intersections.

Saturday June 24th River Bottom Bar and Grill Florence, AZ


