SAFETY CONCERNS

CONSTANT VIGILANCE



UNKNOWNS

How can we avoid something that is unknown? Things can drop out of the sky or fall on you from behind and there is no way to know that it would happen. The best we can do is take protective measures ahead of time. As motorcyclists, those protective measures are the selection of appropriate riding gear. A good helmet is number one. It doesn't have to be the most expensive, but be at least DOT rated and perhaps SNELL approved. A helmet with a solid chin bar offers the best protection. Second is a armored jacket that will resist road rash if one has a "go down." Gloves that can protect all parts of the hands, not just the palm and knuckles. Leather shoes at a minimum, over the ankle shoes or boots are even better. Good denim jeans, not flimsy pants that offer no protection from the pavement. Don't forget eye protection.

With that out of the way, we have come to the time to consider the season. Cooler temperatures bring out creatures not ordinarily seen in the summer heat; deer and perhaps an occasional coyote or javelina. If any one these is sighted there are likely to be others of their sort because they herd together. Any of these coming out of brush, weeds or trees can suddenly appear in your path and cause havoc. Being vigilant in such areas might instill consideration of a different position in your lane. Fractions of time can make a big difference in reaction.

Other unknowns are what we may encounter from operators of other vehicles. People toss items out of their vehicle uncaring or deliberately. Cigarette butts, beverage cans, trash from their fast food lunch to name a few. Also pick-up trucks with anything and everything piled up poorly secured can yield a sudden unknown.

Stay protected and reduce the possibility of falling victim to something unknown.
